SUMMARY

Repairs and maintains Company equipment and/or rolling stock in a safe and productive manner. Operates hand and power tools, shop equipment, forklifts, frontend loaders, heelbooms, bobcats, and Company rolling stock.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES include, but are not limited to the following. Other duties may be assigned.

- Maintains and repairs equipment and/or rolling stock including trucks, forklifts, frontend loaders, heelbooms, bobcats and other rolling stock;
- Performs preventative maintenance on equipment and vehicles, including cleaning, inspecting, testing, operating, and checking fluid levels, changing the oil, and checking tire pressures. Adds fluids, lubricates fittings, and changes tires as needed;
- Reviews maintenance records of HRC vehicles, monitors preventative maintenance schedules and updates records after maintenance or repair work is completed;
- Complies with hazardous materials written programs;
- Operates power tools, jacks, hoists, grinders, welder and cutting torch; may cut, braze, weld and fabricate;
- Works as an integral part of the Company shop team;
- Cleans up shop, wash bay and surrounding area daily;
- Follows safe work practices at all times.

QUALIFICATIONS

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

Must maintain and carry a valid California driver license, have a clean DMV record and remain eligible and capable of operating company vehicles including automobiles and trucks in accordance with company policy guidelines. A qualified candidate will have a current forklift operator's license, or have the ability to obtain current certification.

One year certificate from college or technical school; or three to four years related experience and/or training as a mechanic; or equivalent combination of education and experience.
