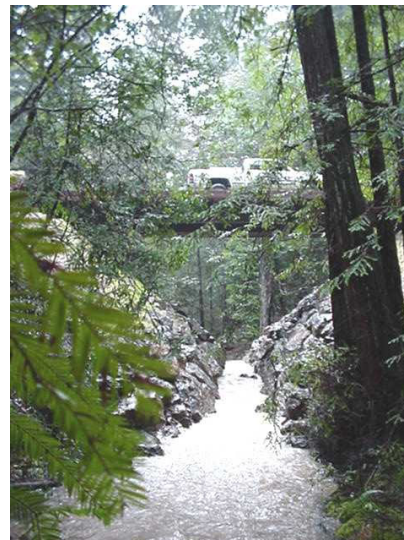


Mendocino Redwood Company Activities – 1998 to Present

Inventory of Conifer Species in 1998:	2.1 billion board feet
Volume Harvested from 1998 through 2019:	740.2 million board feet
Inventory of Conifer Species end of 2019:	3.922 billion board feet
Calculated Growth of Conifer Species from 1998 thru 2019:	2.57 billion board feet
Seedlings planted since 1998:	11,612,879
Soil Removed or Stabilized since 1998:	1,259,495 cubic yards, larger than the Empire State Building (or 125,950 truck loads)
Roads rocked, abandoned or improved since 1998:	123.8 miles
Road crossing upgrades:	Over 3,704 crossings
Fish Barriers Removed (see photos below):	37 fish barrier opening over 27.4 miles of streams

Herbicide applied manually, on a tree by tree basis, in a contained manner over 21 years

Tan Oak Treatment per Acre (2019):	22 ounces per acre treated (2 ³ / ₄ measuring cups per acre)
Tan Oak Treatment on Ownership to Date:	14,145 gallons over 21 years
Tan Oak Treatment Acres Treated Since 1998:	79,570 acres frill method over 21 years
Target conifer trees per acre after treatment:	225
