Inventory of Conifer Species in 2008:	3.9 billion board feet
Volume Harvested from 2008 through 2019:	587.9 million board feet
Inventory of Conifer Species through 2019:	4.87 billion board feet
Calculated Growth of Conifer Species from 2008 through 2019:	1.56 billion board feet
Seedlings planted since 2008:	1,188,535
Soil Removed or Stabilized since 2008:	514,390 cubic yards (or 51,439 truck loads)
Miles of road stormproofed since 2008:	757.5 miles
Road crossing upgrades:	1,985

### ***Herbicide applied manually, on a tree by tree basis, in a contained manner over 11 years***

Tan Oak Treatment per Acre (2019):	30 ounces per acre treated (3 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>4</sub> measuring cups per acre)
Tan Oak Treatment on Ownership to Date:	2601 gallons over 11 years
Tan Oak Treatment Acres Treated Since 2008:	12,357 acres frill method over 11 years
Target conifer trees per acre after treatment:	275
