Inventory of Conifer Species in 2008:	3.9 billion board feet
Volume Harvested from 2008 through 2021:	684.6 million board feet
Inventory of Conifer Species through 2021:	4.72 billion board feet
Calculated Growth of Conifer Species from 2008 through 2021:	1.50 billion board feet
Seedlings planted since 2008:	1,566,896
Soil Removed or Stabilized since 2008:	523,312 cubic yards (or 52,331 truckloads)
Miles of road stormproofed since 2008:	795.3 miles

Herbicide applied manually, on a tree-by-tree basis, in a contained manner over 13 years

Tan Oak Treatment per Acre:	26.6 ounces per acre treated (3.3 measuring cups per acre)
Tan Oak Treatment on Ownership to Date:	3,021 gallons over 13 years
Tan Oak Treatment Acres Treated Since 2008:	14,508 acres over 13 years
Target conifer trees per acre after treatment:	275
