Inventory of Conifer Species in 2008:	3.9 billion board feet
Volume Harvested from 2008 through 2022:	740.0 million board feet
Inventory of Conifer Species through 2022:	4.95 billion board feet
Calculated Growth of Conifer Species from 2008 through 2022:	1.79 billion board feet
Seedlings planted since 2008:	1,700,593

### ***Herbicide applied manually, on a tree-by-tree basis, in a contained manner over 14 years***

Tan Oak Treatment per Acre:	26.6 ounces per acre treated (3.3 measuring cups per acre)
Tan Oak Treatment on Ownership to Date:	3,162 gallons over 14 years
Tan Oak Treatment Acres Treated Since 2008:	15,250 acres over 14 years
Target conifer trees per acre after treatment:	275
