

## Humboldt Redwood Company Activities – 2008 to Present

Inventory of Conifer Species in 2008:	3.9 billion board feet
Volume Harvested from 2008 through 2017:	480.6 million board feet
Inventory of Conifer Species through 2017:	4.76 billion board feet
Calculated Growth of Conifer Species from 2008 through 2017:	1.34 billion board feet
Seedlings planted since 2008:	964,075
Estimated conifers > 8 inches in diameter on property:	29 million
Soil Removed or Stabilized since 2008:	473,301 cubic yards or 47,330 truck loads
Miles of road stormproofed since 2008:	683.4 miles
Road crossing upgrades:	over 1,650 crossings

### ***Herbicide applied manually, on a tree by tree basis, in a contained manner over 10 years***

Tan Oak Treatment per Acre:	25 ounces per acre treated - 2.8 measuring cups per acre
Tan Oak Treatment on Ownership to Date:	1,654 gallons over 10 years
Tan Oak Treatment Acres Treated Since 2008:	8,502 acres frill method over 10 years
Target conifer trees per acre after treatment:	275
