Inventory of Conifer Species in 2008:	3.9 billion board feet
Volume Harvested from 2008 through 2020:	642.7 million board feet
Inventory of Conifer Species through 2020:	4.95 billion board feet
Calculated Growth of Conifer Species from 2008 through 2020:	1.69 billion board feet
Seedlings planted since 2008:	1,303,249
Soil Removed or Stabilized since 2008:	520,180 cubic yards (or 52,018 truckloads)
Miles of road stormproofed since 2008:	785 miles

Herbicide applied manually, on a tree-by-tree basis, in a contained manner over 12 years

Tan Oak Treatment per Acre:	26.9 ounces per acre treated (3.3 measuring cups per acre)
Tan Oak Treatment on Ownership to Date:	2,877 gallons over 12 years
Tan Oak Treatment Acres Treated Since 2008:	13,677 acres over 12 years
Target conifer trees per acre after treatment:	275
