Inventory of Conifer Species in 1998:	2.1 billion board feet
Volume Harvested from 1998 through 2017:	673.4 million board feet
Inventory of Conifer Species end of 2017:	3.698 billion board feet
Calculated Growth of Conifer Species from 1998 thru 2017:	2.55 billion board feet
Seedlings planted since 1998:	10.9 million
Estimated conifer trees > 8" in diameter on property:	Over 35 million estimated
Soil Removed or Stabilized since 1998:	1,184,000 cubic yards, larger than the Empire State Building or 118,400 truck loads
Roads rocked, abandoned or improved since 1998:	119.4 miles
Road crossing upgrades:	Over 3,000 crossings
Fish Barriers Removed (see photos below):	37 fish barrier opening over 27.4 miles of streams

Herbicide applied manually, on a tree by tree basis, in a contained manner over 19 years

Tan Oak Treatment per Acre:	23 ounces per acre treated - 2.8 measuring cups per acre
Tan Oak Treatment on Ownership to Date:	13,318 gallons over 20 years
Tan Oak Treatment Acres Treated Since 1998:	75,570 acres frill method over 20 years
Target conifer trees per acre after treatment:	225
